Statistics Canada releases labour market data for college and university graduates on November 5, 2020

Statistics Canada (Statscan) recently released the report **Labour market outcomes for college and university graduates, 2010 to 2016**. This report includes information on the median employment income by educational qualification, field of study, age group, gender, and status of student in Canada—for Canada, the provinces and the territories. The data used for the calculation of graduate outcome indicators are derived from the Postsecondary Student Information System integrated with the T1 Family File.

Canada -- 181,525 Graduates

- Median employment income two years after graduating: \$47,800
- Median employment income five years after graduating: \$58,600
- Difference between two and five years after graduating: 23%

Highlights: Master's Degree Findings

Canada -- 46,770 Graduates

- Median employment income two years after graduating: \$65,600
- Median employment income five years after graduating: \$75,600
- Difference between two and five years after graduating: 15%
